- Sec. 3. Barack Obama Day. August 4th of each year is
- 8 designated as Barack Obama Day, to be observed throughout the
- 9 State as a day set apart to honor the 44th President of the
- 10 United States of America who began his career serving the
- 11 People of Illinois in both the Illinois State Senate and the
- 12 United States Senate, and dedicated his life to protecting the
- rights of Americans and building bridges across communities.
