1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 57

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 57 on page 14, by  
3 replacing lines 1 through 16 with the following:

4 "(A) Unless a condition described in subparagraph  
5 (B) of this paragraph exists, the court may, upon  
6 request by the petitioner, order a wireless telephone  
7 service provider to transfer to the petitioner the  
8 right to continue to use a telephone number or numbers  
9 indicated by the petitioner and the financial  
10 responsibility associated with the number or numbers,  
11 as set forth in subparagraph (C) of this paragraph. For  
12 purposes of this paragraph (18), the term "wireless  
13 telephone service provider" means a provider of  
14 commercial mobile service as defined in 47 U.S.C. 332.  
15 The petitioner may request the transfer of each  
16 telephone number that the petitioner, or a minor child  
17 in his or her custody, uses. The clerk of the court  
18 shall serve the order on the wireless telephone service

1           provider's agent for service of process provided to the  
2           Illinois Commerce Commission. The order shall contain  
3           all of the following:

4                   (i) The name and billing telephone number of  
5                   the account holder including the name of the  
6                   wireless telephone service provider that serves  
7                   the account."; and

8           on page 16, by inserting immediately below line 4 the  
9           following:

10                   "(F) All wireless service providers that provide  
11                   services to residential customers shall provide to the  
12                   Illinois Commerce Commission the name and address of an  
13                   agent for service of orders entered under this  
14                   paragraph (18). Any change in status of the registered  
15                   agent must be reported to the Illinois Commerce  
16                   Commission within 30 days of such change.

17                   (G) The Illinois Commerce Commission shall  
18                   maintain the list of registered agents for service for  
19                   each wireless telephone service provider on the  
20                   Commission's website. The Commission may consult with  
21                   wireless telephone service providers and the Circuit  
22                   Court Clerks on the manner in which this information is  
23                   provided and displayed."; and

24           on page 36, by replacing lines 11 through 26 with the

1 following:

2 "(A) Unless a condition described in subparagraph  
3 (B) of this paragraph exists, the court may, upon  
4 request by the petitioner, order a wireless telephone  
5 service provider to transfer to the petitioner the  
6 right to continue to use a telephone number or numbers  
7 indicated by the petitioner and the financial  
8 responsibility associated with the number or numbers,  
9 as set forth in subparagraph (C) of this paragraph. For  
10 purposes of this paragraph (18), the term "wireless  
11 telephone service provider" means a provider of

25 following:

1           "(F) All wireless service providers that provide  
2           services to residential customers shall provide to the  
3           Illinois Commerce Commission the name and address of an  
4           agent for service of orders entered under this  
5           paragraph (18). Any change in status of the registered  
6           agent must be reported to the Illinois Commerce  
7           Commission within 30 days of such change.

8           (G) The Illinois Commerce Commission shall  
9           maintain the list of registered agents for service for  
10           each wireless telephone service provider on the  
11           Commission's website. The Commission may consult with  
12           wireless telephone service providers and the Circuit  
13           Court Clerks on the manner in which this information is  
14           provided and displayed."
