AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 3-698 as follows:

Sec. 3-698. U.S. Air Force License Plates.

8 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and 9 applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue special registration plates designated as U.S. 10 Air Force license plates to residents of Illinois who meet 11 eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of State. 12 The special plate issued under this Section shall be affixed 13 14 only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 15 16 pounds, and recreational vehicles as defined by Section 1-169 of this Code. Plates issued under this Section shall expire 17 according to the multi-year procedure established by Section 18 19 3-414.1 of this Code.

20 (b) The design, color, and format of the plates shall be 21 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary of State, except 22 that the U.S. Air Force emblem shall appear on the plates. issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The plates are not required to designate "Land Of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The Secretary shall prescribe the eligibility requirements and, in his or her discretion, shall approve and prescribe stickers or decals as provided under Section 3-412.

8 (c) An applicant shall be charged a \$20 fee for original 9 issuance in addition to the applicable registration fee. Of 10 this additional fee, \$15 shall be deposited into the Secretary 11 of State Special License Plate Fund and \$5 shall be deposited 12 into the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund. For each registration renewal period, a \$20 fee, in addition to the 13 14 appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. Of this 15 additional fee, \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of 16 State Special License Plate Fund and \$18 shall be deposited 17 into the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund.

(d) The Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund is created 18 19 as a special fund in the State treasury. All moneys in the 20 Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund shall be paid, subject 21 to appropriation by the General Assembly and approval by the 22 Secretary, as grants to the Rantoul Historical Society and 23 Museum, or any other charitable foundation responsible for the 24 former exhibits and collections of the Chanute Air Museum, 25 Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Foundation of Illinois for 26 operational and program expenses of the Chanute Air Museum and

1 <u>any other structure housing exhibits and collections of the</u> 2 <u>Chanute Air Museum</u>.
