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1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 275 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 275 by replacing 2 everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Law 4 5 Enforcement Gang Database Information Act. 6 Section 5. Definitions. In this Act: 7 "Gang" has the same meaning ascribed to the term in Section 8 10 of the Illinois Streetgang Terrorism Omnibus Prevention Act. "Gang database" means any database, or data maintained in 9 multiple databases accessed by a law enforcement agency with 10 the primary purpose to designate a person as an associate or 11 12 alleged member of a gang, streetgang, or organization defined 13 in Section 10 of the Illinois Streetgang Terrorism Omnibus 14 Prevention Act, or includes or points to information,

including, but not limited to, fact-based or uncorroborated

information, that reflects a designation of that person as a

- 1 gang member, not including law enforcement agency case reports,
- dispatching notes, or dispatch system records. 2
- "Gang member" has the same meaning ascribed to the term in 3
- 4 Section 10 of the Illinois Streetgang Terrorism Omnibus
- 5 Prevention Act.
- "Law enforcement agency" means an agency of this State or 6
- unit of local government who is primarily responsible for the 7
- detection, investigation, or prevention of crime and the 8
- 9 enforcement of the criminal laws of this State.
- 10 "Shared gang database" means a gang database that is
- 11 accessed by an agency or person outside of the agency that
- created the records that populate the database. 12
- 13 Section 10. Requirements for use of gang databases and
- 14 shared gang databases. Each law enforcement agency who
- 15 maintains a gang database or has access to a shared gang
- database shall have a policy regarding those databases. Each 16
- policy shall be implemented on or before July 1, 2019, except 17
- the requirements in paragraph (1) of this Section shall be 18
- 19 implemented as soon as practicable after the effective date of
- 20 this Act. The policy shall include, but not be limited to:
- 21 (1) that personnel authorized to access a gang database or
- 22 shared gang database are limited to sworn law enforcement
- 23 personnel, non-sworn law enforcement support personnel,
- 24 criminal justice entities, or non-criminal justice technical
- 25 or maintenance personnel, including information technology and

- 1 information security staff and contract employees, who have
- been subject to character or security clearance and who have 2
- 3 received approved training;
- 4 (2) any records contained in a gang database, shared gang
- 5 database, gang-related information in a law enforcement agency
- case report, gang-related information in a law enforcement 6
- agency dispatch note, or gang-related information in a law 7
- 8 enforcement agency dispatch system record shall not be
- 9 disclosed, including, but not limited to, for the following
- 10 purposes: employment, education, licensing, or housing, except
- 11 that law enforcement and criminal justice entities may use
- information contained in a gang database or shared gang 12
- 13 database for employment purposes, and records contained in a
- 14 gang database or shared gang database may be disclosed to
- 15 comply with federal law, for national security or homeland
- 16 security purposes, for military screening purposes, or for
- 17 other appropriate law enforcement purpose;
- 18 (3) security procedures; and
- 19 (4) the review and purge process from gang databases and
- shared gang databases. 20
- Section 105. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is 21
- amended by adding Section 115-10.5a as follows: 22
- 2.3 (725 ILCS 5/115-10.5a new)
- Sec. 115-10.5a. Admissibility of evidence concerning gang 24

- (a) In this Section, "gang database", "gang member", and 2
- "shared gang database" have the same meanings ascribed to those 3
- 4 terms as in Section 5 of the Law Enforcement Gang Database
- 5 Information Act.
- (b) In all criminal cases, evidence which indicates the 6
- 7 mere presence that the person was or is on a gang database or a
- shared gang database is not admissible. 8
- 9 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- becoming law.". 10
