AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Firearm Seizure Act is amended by changing
Section 1 as follows:

6 (725 ILCS 165/1) (from Ch. 38, par. 161-1)

7 Sec. 1. When a complaint is made to any circuit court that 8 that a person possessing a firearm or firearms has threatened 9 to use a firearm illegally, the court shall examine on oath such complainant, and any witnesses which may be produced, 10 reduce the complaint to writing and have it subscribed and 11 sworn to by the complainant. If the court is satisfied that 12 there is any danger of such illegal use of firearms, it shall 13 14 issue a warrant requiring the apprehension of such person, hereafter referred to as the defendant, for appearance before 15 16 the court. Such warrant shall also authorize the seizure of any firearm in the possession of the defendant. 17
