Amend Senate Bill 768 on page 10, by replacing lines 1 through 6 with the following: 3 "(5) The Secretary may shall consider the recommendation of 4 5 the Board on all matters and questions relating to this Act, such as: (i) matters relating to continuing education, 6 7 including the number of hours necessary for license renewal, waivers for those unable to meet such requirements, and 8 acceptable course content and (ii) rules for administration of 9 this Act."; and 10 11 by replacing line 21 on page 15 through line 2 on page 16 with 12 the following: "(c) Licensed social workers may not engage in independent 13 14 practice of clinical social work without a clinical social

worker license. In independent practice, a licensed social

- worker shall practice at all times under the order, control, 1
- and full professional responsibility of a licensed clinical 2
- social worker, a licensed clinical psychologist, a licensed 3
- 4 clinical professional counselor, a licensed marriage and
- 5 family therapist, or a psychiatrist, as defined in Section
- 1-121 of the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities 6
- Code."; and 7
- 8 on page 25, by replacing lines 1 through 6 with the following:
- "(e) Failure of any person to submit to a mental or 9
- physical examination without reasonable cause, when ordered 10
- directed, shall result in an automatic be grounds for 11
- suspension of his or her $\frac{1}{2}$ license until the person submits to 12
- 13 the examination if the Board finds, after notice and hearing,
- 14 that the refusal to submit to the examination was without
- 15 reasonable cause.".
