

## 100TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2017 and 2018 SB1240

Introduced 2/7/2017, by Sen. James F. Clayborne, Jr.

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

220 ILCS 5/5-117

Amends the Public Utilities Act. Requires all local exchange telecommunications carriers with at least 35,000 subscriber access lines, any person or entity providing cable service or video service, and any wireless telephone carrier and internet service provider serving Illinois residents to submit an annual report concerning procurement goals and actual spending for female-owned, minority-owned, veteran-owned, and small business enterprises. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by changing

  Section 5-117 as follows:

- 8 Sec. 5-117. Supplier diversity goals.
- 9 (a) The public policy of this State is to collaboratively
  10 work with companies that serve Illinois residents to improve
  11 their supplier diversity in a non-antagonistic manner.
- (b) The Commission shall require all gas, electric, and 12 water companies with at least 100,000 customers under its 13 14 authority to submit an annual report by April 15, 2015 and every April 15 thereafter, in a searchable Adobe PDF format, on 15 16 all procurement goals and actual spending for female-owned, minority-owned, veteran-owned, and small business enterprises 17 in the previous calendar year. These goals shall be expressed 18 19 as a percentage of the total work performed by the entity 20 submitting the report, and the actual spending for all 21 female-owned, minority-owned, veteran-owned, and 22 business enterprises shall also be expressed as a percentage of the total work performed by the entity submitting the report. 23

The provisions of this subsection (b) regarding the submission
of an annual report on procurement goals and actual spending
shall also apply to all local exchange telecommunications
carriers with at least 35,000 subscriber access lines, any
person or entity providing cable service or video service, as
defined in Section 21-201 of this Act, and any wireless
telephone carrier and internet service provider serving
Illinois residents.

- (c) Each participating company in its annual report shall include the following information:
  - (1) an explanation of the plan for the next year to increase participation;
    - (2) an explanation of the plan to increase the goals;
    - (3) the areas of procurement each company shall be actively seeking more participation in in the next year;
  - (4) an outline of the plan to alert and encourage potential vendors in that area to seek business from the company;
  - (5) an explanation of the challenges faced in finding quality vendors and offer any suggestions for what the Commission could do to be helpful to identify those vendors;
  - (6) a list of the certifications the company recognizes;
  - (7) the point of contact for any potential vendor who wishes to do business with the company and explain the

- process for a vendor to enroll with the company as a minority-owned, women-owned, or veteran-owned company; and
  - (8) any particular success stories to encourage other companies to emulate best practices.
    - (d) Each annual report shall include as much State-specific data as possible. If the submitting entity does not submit State-specific data, then the company shall include any national data it does have and explain why it could not submit State-specific data and how it intends to do so in future reports, if possible.
    - (e) Each annual report shall include the rules, regulations, and definitions used for the procurement goals in the company's annual report.
    - (f) The Commission and all participating entities shall hold an annual workshop open to the public in 2015 and every year thereafter on the state of supplier diversity to collaboratively seek solutions to structural impediments to achieving stated goals, including testimony from each participating entity as well as subject matter experts and advocates. The Commission shall publish a database on its website of the point of contact for each participating entity for supplier diversity, along with a list of certifications each company recognizes from the information submitted in each annual report. The Commission shall publish each annual report on its website and shall maintain each annual report for at least 5 years.

These goals 16 shall be expressed as a percentage of the total work performed by the entity submitting the report, and the actual spending 17 for all female-owned, minority-owned, veteran-owned, and small 18 19 business enterprises shall also be expressed as a percentage of 20 the total work performed by the entity submitting the report. 21 The provisions of this subsection (b) regarding the submission 22 of an annual report on procurement goals and actual spending 23 shall also apply to all local exchange telecommunications 24 carriers with at least 35,000 subscriber access lines, any person or entity providing cable service or video service, as 25
