- 8 <u>(a)</u> A person may use a crossbow if one or more of the following conditions are met:
- 10 (1) the user is a person age 62 and older;
- 11 (2) the user is a person with a disability to whom the
  12 Director has issued a permit to use a crossbow, as provided
  13 by administrative rule; or
  - (3) the date of using the crossbow is during the period of the second Monday following the Thanksgiving holiday through the last day of the archery deer hunting season (both inclusive) set annually by the Director.
- 18 <u>(b)</u> As used in this Section, "person with a disability"
  19 means a person who has a physical impairment due to injury or
  20 disease, congenital or acquired, which renders the person so
  21 severely disabled as to be unable to use a longbow, recurve
  22 bow, or compound bow. Permits must be issued only after the
  23 receipt of a physician's statement confirming the applicant is

- a person with a disability as defined above. 1
- 2 (c) A person may use a crossbow to take coyotes when it is
- 3 legal to use a bow and arrow to take coyotes.
