3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No.  
4 2 as follows:

5 on page 67, by replacing lines 5 through 9 with the following:  
6 "supervised release for first degree murder, a forcible felony  
7 as defined in Section 2-8 of the Criminal Code of 2012, any  
8 felony that requires registration as a sex offender under the  
9 Sex Offender Registration Act, or a Class X felony or Class 1  
10 felony that is not a violation of the Cannabis Control Act, the  
11 Illinois Controlled Substances Act, or the Methamphetamine  
12 Control and Community Protection Act, shall be"; and

13 on page 67, by replacing lines 21 through 25 with the  
14 following:

15 "supervised release for first degree murder, a forcible felony  
16 as defined in Section 2-8 of the Criminal Code of 2012, any

1 felony that requires registration as a sex offender under the  
2 Sex Offender Registration Act, or a Class X felony or Class 1  
3 felony that is not a violation of the Cannabis Control Act, the  
4 Illinois Controlled Substances Act, or the Methamphetamine  
5 Control and Community Protection Act. Low level"; and

6 on page 82, by replacing lines 11 through 15 with the  
7 following:

8 "supervised release for first degree murder, a forcible felony  
9 as defined in Section 2-8 of the Criminal Code of 2012, any  
10 felony that requires registration as a sex offender under the  
11 Sex Offender Registration Act, or a Class X felony or Class 1  
12 felony that is not a violation of the Cannabis Control Act, the  
13 Illinois Controlled Substances Act, or the Methamphetamine  
14 Control and Community Protection Act, shall be"; and

15 on page 83, by replacing lines 1 through 5 with the following:

16 "supervised release for first degree murder, a forcible felony  
17 as defined in Section 2-8 of the Criminal Code of 2012, any  
18 felony that requires registration as a sex offender under the  
19 Sex Offender Registration Act, or a Class X felony or Class 1  
20 felony that is not a violation of the Cannabis Control Act, the  
21 Illinois Controlled Substances Act, or the Methamphetamine  
22 Control and Community Protection Act. Low level"; and

23 on page 212, line 12, by deleting "and"; and

1 on page 212, line 14, by replacing the period with "; and"; and

2 on page 212, immediately below line 14, by inserting the  
3 following:

4 "(7) information about community-based employment  
5 services and employment service programs available for  
6 persons with prior arrest or criminal convictions."
