

## 100TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2017 and 2018 SB1708

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/1-10.5 new

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that as a condition of initial eligibility for any benefits under the Code, an applicant must pass a drug screening. Provides that as a condition of continued eligibility for benefits, a recipient must pass random drug screenings as prescribed by the Department of Human Services or the Department of Healthcare and Family Services. Effective immediately.

- 5 adding Section 1-10.5 as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 1-10.5. Drug screening. As a condition of initial</u>
- 8 eligibility for any benefits under this Code, an applicant must
- 9 pass a drug screening. As a condition of continued eligibility
- 10 for any benefits under this Code, a recipient must pass random
- drug screenings as prescribed by the Department of Human
- 12 Services or the Department of Healthcare and Family Services.
- 13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 14 becoming law.
