1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1730

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1730 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Renter's Financial Responsibility and
5 Protection Act is amended by changing Section 15 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 27/15)

7 Sec. 15. Prohibited practices.

8 (a) A rental company may not sell a damage waiver unless
9 the renter agrees to the damage waiver in writing at or prior
10 to the time the rental agreement is executed.

11 (b) A rental company may not void a damage waiver except
12 for one or more of the following reasons:

13 (1) Damage or loss while the rental vehicle is used to
14 carry persons or property for a charge or fee.

15 (2) Damage or loss during an organized or agreed upon
16 racing or speed contest or demonstration or pushing or

1 pulling activity in which the rental vehicle is actively
2 involved.

3 (3) Damage or loss that could reasonably be expected
4 from an intentional or criminal act of the driver other
5 than a traffic infraction.

6 (4) Damage or loss to any rental vehicle resulting from
7 any auto business operation, including but not limited to
8 repairing, servicing, testing, washing, parking, storing,
9 or selling of automobiles.

10 (5) Damage or loss occurring to a rental vehicle if the
11 rental contract is based on fraudulent or material
12 misrepresentation by the renter.

13 (6) Damage or loss arising out of the use of the rental
14 vehicle outside the continental United States when such use
15 is specifically prohibited in the rental agreement.

16 (7) Damage or loss occurring while the rental vehicle
17 is operated by a driver not permitted under the rental
18 agreement.

19 (8) Damage or loss occurring while the rental vehicle
20 is operated by a driver under the influence of alcohol,
21 other drug or drugs, intoxicating compound or compounds, or
22 any combination thereof and convicted of violating
23 subsection (a) of Section 11-501 of the Illinois Vehicle
24 Code.

25 (9) Failure of renter to return the rental vehicle's
26 keys to the rental company.

1 (c) A rental company shall not charge more than \$12.50 per
2 full or partial 24 hour rental day for a collision damage
3 waiver prior to January 1, 2014. Beginning January 1, 2014, a
4 rental company shall not charge more than \$13.50 per full or
5 partial 24 hour rental day for a collision damage waiver.

6 (d) A rental company may offer a collision damage waiver on
7 any rental vehicle having a value in excess of a Manufacturer's
8 Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) of \$50,000; however, the
9 provisions of subsection (c) of this Section shall not apply to
10 collision damage waivers under this subsection (d).
