

100TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2017 and 2018 SB1973

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

220 ILCS 5/16-126.1

Amends the Public Utilities Act. Provides that the State may not, rather than shall not, directly prohibit a qualifying electric utility from seeking membership in a Federal Energy Regulatory Commission approved regional transmission organization of its choosing.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 16-126.1 as follows:
- 6 (220 ILCS 5/16-126.1)
- 7 Sec. 16-126.1. Regional transmission organization
- 8 memberships. The State <u>may</u> shall not directly or indirectly
- 9 prohibit an electric utility that on December 31, 2005 provided
- 10 electric service to at least 100,000 customers in Illinois from
- 11 membership in a Federal Energy Regulatory Commission approved
- regional transmission organization of its choosing. Nothing in
- this Section limits any authority the Commission otherwise has
- 14 to regulate that electric utility. This Section ceases to be
- 15 effective on July 1, 2022 unless extended by the General
- 16 Assembly by law.
