SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, as follows:

Other State Funds	\$ 290,486,000
Federal Funds	<u>\$1,016,289,400</u>
Total	\$1,329,925,400

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A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 OPERATIONAL EXPENSES

6 Section 5. In addition to other amounts appropriated, the
7 amount of \$10,750,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
8 respectively, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
9 the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for
10 operational expenses, awards, grants and permanent improvements
11 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018.

12 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the

23 Total \$260,000,000

24 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July

1 1, 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General
2 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced
3 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
