#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Independent Tax Tribunal for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, as follows:

General Funds	\$638,900
Other State Funds	<u>\$168,700</u>
Total	\$807,600

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The sum of \$638,900, or so much thereof as may  
6 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to  
7 the Illinois Independent Tax Tribunal to meet its operational  
8 expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018.

9 Section 5. The sum of \$168,700, or so much thereof as may  
10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Independent Tax  
11 Tribunal Fund to the Illinois Independent Tax Tribunal to meet  
12 its operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
13 2018.

14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
15 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100<sup>th</sup> General  
16 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced  
17 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
