1 Section 5. The sum of \$70,000, or so much thereof as may 2 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 3 the Southern Illinois University for any costs associated with 4 the Daily Egyptian Newspaper.

5 Section 10. The amount of \$169,554,700, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education 7 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois 8 University to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year 9 ending June 30, 2018.

10 Section 15. The sum of \$27,000, or so much thereof as may 11 be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and 12 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern 13 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards.

14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 15 2017, if and only if Senate Bill 2063 of the 100th General 16 Assembly (the Unbalanced Budget Response Act), as introduced 17 in the Illinois Senate, becomes law.
