A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$5,242,003, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Build Illinois Bond
6 Fund to the Capital Development Board for early childhood
7 construction grants to school districts and not-for-profit
8 providers of early childhood services for children ages birth
9 to 5 years of age for construction or renovation of early
10 childhood facilities, with priority given to projects located
11 in those communities in this State with the greatest
12 underserved population of young children, as identified by the
13 Capital Development Board, in consultation with the State Board
14 of Education, using census data and other reliable local early
15 childhood service data, and other capital improvements.

16 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
17 becoming law.
