SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 490/133 new

Amends the State Commemorative Dates Act. Designates May 17th of each year as Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma (DIPG) Awareness Day to be observed throughout the State as a day to encourage the people of Illinois to help increase public awareness of this particularly aggressive form of cancer affecting children.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by
adding Section 133 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 490/133 new)

7 Sec. 133. Diffuse Intrinsic Pontine Glioma (DIPG) Awareness Day. May 17th of each year is designated as Diffuse 8 9 Intrinsic Pontine Glioma (DIPG) Awareness Day. Brain tumors are 10 the leading cause of cancer-related deaths in children, and DIPG is a highly aggressive brain tumor that affects roughly 11 12 300 children a year in the United States. DIPG Awareness Day is to be observed throughout the State as a day to encourage the 13 14 people of Illinois to help increase public awareness of this particularly aggressive form of cancer affecting children. 15
