SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/11-1301.4

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-1301.4

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the Secretary of State may issue a one-time decal or device to any non-resident of this State who is a person with disabilities and who is displaced from another jurisdiction due to a national disaster as declared by the federal government. Provides proof requirements for the temporary decal or device. Provides that the decal or device shall be valid for a period not to exceed 6 months. Effective January 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
5 Section 11-1301.4 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/11-1301.4) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-1301.4)

7 Sec. 11-1301.4. Reciprocal agreements with other
8 jurisdictions; temporary decal.

9 (a) The Secretary of State, or his designee, may enter into
10 agreements with other jurisdictions, including foreign
11 jurisdictions, on behalf of this State relating to the
12 extension of parking privileges by such jurisdictions to
13 residents of this State with disabilities who display a special
14 license plate or parking device that contains the International
15 symbol of access on his or her motor vehicle, and to recognize
16 such plates or devices issued by such other jurisdictions. This
17 State shall grant the same parking privileges which are granted
18 to residents of this State with disabilities to any
19 non-resident whose motor vehicle is licensed in another state,
20 district, territory or foreign country if such vehicle displays
21 the International symbol of access or a distinguishing insignia
22 on license plates or parking device issued in accordance with
23 the laws of the non-resident's state, district, territory or

1 foreign country.

2 (b) The Secretary may issue a one-time decal or device to
3 any non-resident of this State who is a person with
4 disabilities and who is displaced from another jurisdiction due
5 to a national disaster as declared by the federal government.
6 The person shall provide the Secretary proof that he or she is
7 residing at an Illinois residence for the duration of his or
8 her time in this State and proof of disability, including, but
9 not limited to, a device or decal issued by another
10 jurisdiction, a designation on a driver's license or
11 identification card issued by another jurisdiction, or a
12 medical certification by an Illinois licensed physician,
13 physician assistant, or advanced practice registered nurse. A
14 device or decal issued under this subsection (b) shall be valid
15 for a period not to exceed 6 months.
