SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-414.1

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-414.1

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that beginning with the 2020 registration year, the Secretary of State shall offer to each owner of a motor vehicle of the first division or motor vehicle of the second division weighing no more than 8,000 pounds a registration period based on a one calendar year or 2 calendar year basis. Provides that the Secretary shall offer to each owner of a motor vehicle of the first division that is a new vehicle or motor vehicle of the second division weighing no more than 8,000 pounds that is a new vehicle a registration period based on a one calendar year, 2 calendar year, or 5 calendar year basis. Provides that the owner of the motor vehicle shall pay the required registration fee under the Code that shall, if applicable, be increased to reflect the registration year period chosen by the motor vehicle owner.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
5 Section 3-414.1 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-414.1) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-414.1)

7 Sec. 3-414.1. Term of multi-year registration plates.

8 (a) Registration plates issued for motor vehicles shall be
9 valid for an indefinite term of not less than one year.
10 Registration plates issued as two-year or five-year plates may
11 be issued as multi-year plates at the discretion of the
12 Secretary of State. Current renewal registration stickers,
13 when necessary, are to be attached as provided in Section
14 3-413. The Secretary may in his discretion prescribe a term
15 greater than one year or may extend the term of current
16 registration plates for an additional calendar year by
17 appropriate public announcement made before August 1 of the
18 current registration year.

19 (a-5) Beginning with the 2020 registration year, the
20 Secretary shall offer to each owner of a motor vehicle of the
21 first division or motor vehicle of the second division weighing
22 no more than 8,000 pounds that is subject to registration under
23 this Chapter a registration period based on a one calendar year

1 or 2 calendar year basis. The owner of the motor vehicle shall
2 pay the required registration fee under Section 3-806, 3-815,
3 or 3-818 of this Code that shall, if applicable, be increased
4 to reflect the registration year period chosen by the motor
5 vehicle owner.

6 (a-10) Beginning with the 2020 registration year, the
7 Secretary shall offer to each owner of a motor vehicle of the
8 first division that is a new vehicle or motor vehicle of the
9 second division weighing no more than 8,000 pounds that is a
10 new vehicle, as defined under Section 1-148.4 of this Code, and
11 that is subject to registration under this Chapter a
12 registration period based on a one calendar year, 2 calendar
13 year, or 5 calendar year basis. The owner of the motor vehicle
14 shall pay the required registration fee under Section 3-806,
15 3-815, or 3-818 of this Code that shall, if applicable, be
16 increased to reflect the registration year period chosen by the
17 motor vehicle owner.

18 (b) Registration plates issued to owners of vehicles
19 subject to annual registration for the first time during the
20 term of the plates shall be valid until the expiration of the
21 term. Current annual registration stickers are to be attached
22 as provided in Section 3-413.
