### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 115/10-5.3

Amends the River Edge Redevelopment Zone Act. Provides that, on and after the effective date, the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity may certify as a River Edge Redevelopment Zone any area that meets the qualifications set forth in the Act.

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AN ACT concerning local government.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The River Edge Redevelopment Zone Act is amended
by changing Section 10-5.3 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 115/10-5.3)

Sec. 10-5.3. Certification of River Edge Redevelopment
Zones.

9 (a) Approval of designated River Edge Redevelopment Zones shall be made by the Department by certification of the 10 designating ordinance. The Department shall promptly issue a 11 12 certificate for each zone upon its approval. The certificate 13 shall be signed by the Director of the Department, shall make 14 specific reference to the designating ordinance, which shall be attached thereto, and shall be filed in the office of the 15 Secretary of State. A certified copy of the River Edge 16 17 Redevelopment Zone Certificate, or a duplicate original thereof, shall be recorded in the office of the recorder of 18 19 deeds of the county in which the River Edge Redevelopment Zone 20 lies.

(b) A River Edge Redevelopment Zone shall be effective upon
 its certification. The Department shall transmit a copy of the
 certification to the Department of Revenue, and to the

designating municipality. Upon certification of a River Edge
 Redevelopment Zone, the terms and provisions of the designating
 ordinance shall be in effect, and may not be amended or
 repealed except in accordance with Section 10-5.4.

5 (c) A River Edge Redevelopment Zone shall be in effect for 6 the period stated in the certificate, which shall in no event 7 exceed 30 calendar years. Zones shall terminate at midnight of 8 December 31 of the final calendar year of the certified term, 9 except as provided in Section 10-5.4.

10 (d) In calendar years 2006 and 2007, the Department may 11 certify one pilot River Edge Redevelopment Zone in the City of 12 East St. Louis, one pilot River Edge Redevelopment Zone in the 13 City of Rockford, and one pilot River Edge Redevelopment Zone 14 in the City of Aurora.

In calendar year 2009, the Department may certify one pilotRiver Edge Redevelopment Zone in the City of Elgin.

17 On or after <u>July 28, 2011 (the effective date of Public Act</u> 18 <u>97-203)</u> this amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly, the 19 Department may certify one additional pilot River Edge 20 Redevelopment Zone in the City of Peoria.

21 <u>On or after the effective date of this amendatory Act of</u> 22 <u>the 100th General Assembly, the Department may certify as a</u> 23 <u>River Edge Redevelopment Zone any area that meets the</u> 24 <u>qualifications set forth in this Act.</u>

Thereafter the Department may not certify any additional
 River Edge Redevelopment Zones, but may amend and rescind

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1 certifications of existing River Edge Redevelopment Zones in 2 accordance with Section 10-5.4, except that no River Edge 3 Redevelopment Zone may be extended on or after the effective 4 date of this amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly.

5 (d-5) Each River Edge Redevelopment Zone in existence on August 7, 2012 (the effective date of Public Act 97-905) this 6 amendatory Act of the 97th General Assembly shall continue 7 8 until its scheduled termination under this Act, unless the Zone 9 is decertified sooner. At the time of its term expiration each 10 River Edge Redevelopment Zone in existence on August 7, 2012 11 (the effective date of Public Act 97-905) will become an open 12 enterprise zone, available for the previously designated area or a different area to compete for designation as an enterprise 13 zone. No preference for designation as a Zone will be given to 14 15 the previously designated area.

16 (e) A municipality in which a River Edge Redevelopment Zone 17 has been certified must submit to the Department, within 60 days after the certification, a plan for encouraging the 18 19 participation by minority persons, women, persons with 20 disabilities, and veterans in the zone. The Department may assist the municipality in developing and implementing the 21 22 plan. The terms "minority person", "woman", and "person with a 23 disability" have the meanings set forth under Section 2 of the Business Enterprise for Minorities, Women, and Persons with 24 25 Disabilities Act. "Veteran" means an Illinois resident who is a veteran as defined in subsection (h) of Section 1491 of Title 26
