AN ACT concerning local government.

## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Mosquito Abatement District Act is amended
by adding Section 11.5 as follows:

7 Sec. 11.5. Cessation of district organization. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if a majority vote 8 9 of the board of trustees of a mosquito abatement district is in 10 favor of a proposition to annex the district to another mosquito abatement district whose boundaries are contiguous, 11 12 consolidate the district into a municipality whose boundaries are coterminous or substantially coterminous with the 13 14 district, consolidate the district into the township in which the district sits, or consolidate the district into the county 15 in which the district sits, and if the governing authorities of 16 the governmental unit assuming the functions of the former 17 district agree by resolution to accept the functions (and 18 19 jurisdiction over the territory, if applicable) of the consolidated or annexed district, then the district shall 20 21 cease. On the effective date of the annexation or 22 consolidation, all the rights, powers, duties, assets, property, liabilities, indebtedness, obligations, bonding 23

1 <u>authority, taxing authority, and responsibilities of the</u> 2 <u>district shall vest in and be assumed by the governmental unit</u> 3 <u>assuming the functions of the former district.</u>

4 The employees of the former district shall be transferred 5 to the governmental unit assuming the functions of the former 6 district. The governmental unit assuming the functions of the 7 former district shall exercise the rights and responsibilities 8 of the former district with respect to those employees. The 9 status and rights of the employees of the former district under 10 any applicable contracts or collective bargaining agreements, 11 historical representation rights under the Illinois Public 12 Labor Relations Act, or under any pension, retirement, or 13 annuity plan shall not be affected by this amendatory Act of 14 the 100th General Assembly.
