The Children and Family Services Act is amended 4 5 by adding Section 5f as follows: 6 (20 ILCS 505/5f new) 7 Sec. 5f. Payment rate increases for reimbursable services. (a) For State Fiscal Year 2019, the Department shall 8 increase reimbursement rates payable to each foster parent and 10 to each private agency with a purchase of service contract or grant from the Department to an amount that equals the sum of 11 12 all increases in general inflation during State Fiscal Years 13 2009 through 2018 as determined by the Consumer Price Index as

published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the U.S.

Department of Labor, less any rate increases previously

provided by the Department. The contractual and grant services

3	(1) Residential services, including child care
4	institution, group home care, independent living services,
5	or transitional living services.
6	(2) Specialized, adolescent, treatment, or other
7	non-traditional or Home-of-Relative foster care.
8	(3) Traditional or Home-of-Relative foster care.
9	(4) Intact family services.
10	(5) Teen parenting services.
11	(6) Other supportive service grants or contracts.
12	(b) Beginning in State Fiscal Year 2020, and for every
13	State Fiscal Year thereafter, the Department shall implement
14	the rate reimbursement methodology outlined in 89 Ill. Adm.
15	Code 356.5(f) when calculating and determining the payment
16	rates for private agencies that contract with the Department to
17	provide any of the services enumerated in 89 Ill Adm. Code
18	356.5(f) and in paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of this
19	Section. Payment rates calculated and determined as provided in
20	this Section shall include an amount equal to any increase in
21	general inflation as determined by the Consumer Price Index.
22	For services listed under paragraphs (2) through (6) of
23	subsection (a), the Department shall establish a rate model
24	based upon staffing and service expectations for each type of
25	care within 9 months of the start of State Fiscal Year 2019.

For State Fiscal Year 2020 and for every State Fiscal Year

- thereafter, the rate shall be adjusted to an amount equal to 1
- 2 any increase in general inflation as determined by the Consumer
- 3 Price Index.
- The Department shall increase each foster parent rate each 4
- 5 year by an amount equal to any increase in general inflation as
- 6 determined by the Consumer Price Index.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 7
- 8 becoming law.".
