In"; and 6 7 on page 3, line 22, by replacing "100" with "10,000"; and 8 on page 4, line 11, after the period, by inserting ""Large

- (a) If a law enforcement agency uses a drone under Section 5
- 15 of this Act, the agency within 30 days shall destroy all 6
- information gathered by the drone, except that a supervisor at 7
- 8 that agency may retain particular information if:
- 9 (1) there is reasonable suspicion that the information
- 10 contains evidence of criminal activity, or
- the information is relevant to an ongoing 11 (2)
- 12 investigation or pending criminal trial.
- 13 (b) Except as provided under subsection (c) of this
- 14 Section, if a law enforcement agency uses a drone under
- paragraph (7) of Section 15 of this Act, the law enforcement 15
- agency shall destroy all information gathered by the drone 16
- within 7 days, except that a supervisor at that law enforcement 17
- 18 agency may retain particular information if:
- 19 (1) there is reasonable suspicion that the information
- 20 contains evidence of criminal activity; or
- 21 (2) the information is relevant to an ongoing
- 22 investigation or pending criminal trial.
- 23 (c) If a law enforcement agency uses a drone under
- 24 paragraph (7) of Section 15 of this Act at any demonstration,
- protest, rally, march, parade, or other gathering for the 25

information if:

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- purpose of expressing political, religious, social, or other 1 views, the law enforcement agency shall destroy all information 2 gathered by the drone within 24 hours, except that a supervisor 3
- 4 at that law enforcement agency may retain particular
- (1) there is reasonable suspicion that the information 6

contains evidence of criminal activity; or

- (2) the information is relevant to an ongoing 8 9 investigation or pending criminal trial. The law 10 enforcement agency shall limit access to the information gathered by the drone to the highest ranking officer 11 investigating whether there was criminal activity at the 12 13 event. Additionally, the information collected shall not be shared it with any other member of the law enforcement 14 15 agency or any other agency unless the information contains evidence of criminal activity or the information is 16 relevant to an ongoing investigation or pending criminal 17 trial. 18
