

100TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2017 and 2018 SB2893

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/3-6

Amends the Election Code. Provides that notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person who is otherwise qualified to vote may preregister to vote on or after that person's 16th birthday, with the registration held in abeyance by the appropriate election authority until such time as that individual attains the required age to vote. Provides that for the purposes of the Code, an individual who is 16 years of age or older (rather than who is 17 years of age and who will be 18 years of age on the date of the general or consolidated election) shall be deemed competent to execute and attest to any voter registration forms.

1 AN ACT concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 3-6 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/3-6)
- 7 Sec. 3-6. Voting <u>and registration</u> age.
- 8 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person
 9 who is otherwise qualified to vote may preregister to vote on
 10 or after that person's 16th birthday, with the registration
- 11 <u>held in abeyance by the appropriate election authority until</u>
- such time as that individual attains the required age to vote.
- 13 <u>(b)</u> Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person
- 14 who is 17 years old on the date of a caucus, general primary
- 15 election, or consolidated primary election and who is otherwise
- qualified to vote is qualified to vote at that caucus, general
- 17 primary, or consolidated primary, including voting a vote by
- 18 mail, grace period, or early voting ballot with respect to that
- 19 general primary or consolidated primary, if that person will be
- 20 18 years old on the date of the immediately following general
- 21 election or consolidated election for which candidates are
- 22 nominated at that primary.
- 23 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an

- 9 <u>(e)</u> References in this Code and elsewhere to the
- 10 requirement that a person must be 18 years old to vote shall be
- interpreted in accordance with this Section.
- For the purposes of this Code, an individual who is 17
- 13 years of age and who will be 18 years of age on the date of the
- 14 general or consolidated election shall be deemed competent to
- 15 execute and attest to any voter registration forms. An
- 16 individual who is 17 years of age, will be 18 years of age on
- 17 the date of the immediately following general or consolidated
- 18 election, and is otherwise qualified to vote shall be deemed
- 19 eligible to circulate a nominating petition or a petition
- 20 proposing a public question.
