SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

110 ILCS 49/20

Amends the Higher Education Veterans Service Act. Provides that each public college or university that is required to have a Coordinator of Veterans and Military Personnel Student Services shall report to the Board of Higher Education information on the its efforts in attracting, recruiting, and retaining veterans and military personnel at the institution. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Higher Education Veterans Service Act is
amended by changing Section 20 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 49/20)

7 20. Fiscal impact and reporting. Beginning on Sec. September 1 of the year following the effective date of this 8 9 Act and each subsequent September 1, each college and university that is required to have a Coordinator of Veterans 10 and Military Personnel Student Services under subsection (b) of 11 Section 15 20 of this Act shall report to the Board of Higher 12 13 Education on the fiscal impact of the programs and services 14 related to the requirements of this Act. The report shall include information on the efforts of the public college or 15 16 university in attracting, recruiting, and retaining veterans 17 and military personnel at the institution.

18 The Board of Higher Education shall compile the information 19 and, within 60 days after receipt of such information, issue a 20 report reflecting the information for each institution 21 required to report under this Section.
