2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2951 on page 2,
3 line 23, after the period, by inserting "The pilot program
4 shall be implemented across a broad spectrum of geographic
5 regions across the State."; and

6 on page 4, line 18, after the period, by inserting "The model
7 shall take into consideration area workforce, community
8 uniqueness, and cultural diversity."; and

9 on page 6, line 5, by replacing "outcomes and" with
10 "outcomes,."; and

11 on page 6, line 7, by replacing "sustainability" with
12 "sustainability, and shall include all provider costs
13 associated with the data collection for purposes of the
14 analytics and outcomes reporting required under subsection
15 (h)"; and

1 on page 6, line 20, by replacing "report" with "reports"; and

2 on page 7, line 23, by replacing "5" with "4"; and

3 on page 7, line 24, by replacing "implementation" with
4 "implementation, and after 7 years of full implementation,";
5 and

6 on page 8, immediately below line 4, by inserting the
7 following:

8 "The reports to the General Assembly shall be filed with
9 the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of
10 the Senate in electronic form only, in the manner that the
11 Clerk and the Secretary shall direct.

12 Post-pilot program discharge outcomes shall be collected
13 for all service recipients who exit the pilot program for up to
14 3 years after exit. This includes youth who exit the program
15 with planned or unplanned discharges. The post-exit data
16 collected shall include the annual data listed in paragraphs
17 (1) through (9) of subsection (h). Data collection shall be
18 done in a manner that does not violate individual privacy laws.
19 Outcomes for enrollees in the pilot and post-exit outcomes
20 shall be included in the final report to the General Assembly
21 under this subsection (i) within one year of 4 full years of
22 implementation, and in an additional report within one year of

1 7 full years of implementation in order to provide more
2 information about post-exit outcomes on a greater number of
3 youth who enroll in pilot program services in the final years
4 of the pilot program."; and

5 on page 9, line 7, after the period, by inserting "The pilot
6 program shall be implemented across a broad spectrum of
7 geographic regions across the State."; and

8 on page 9, line 13, after the period, by inserting "The model
9 shall take into consideration area workforce, community
10 uniqueness, and cultural diversity."; and

11 on page 11, line 10, by replacing "outcomes and" with
12 "outcomes,."; and

13 on page 11, line 12, by replacing "sustainability" with
14 "sustainability, and shall include all provider costs
15 associated with the data collection for purposes of the
16 analytics and outcomes reporting required in subsection (g)";
17 and

18 on page 11, line 23, by replacing "report" with "reports"; and

19 on page 12, by replacing line 22 through line 2 on page 13 with
20 the following:

1 "(h) The Department of Healthcare and Family Services shall
2 deliver a final report to the General Assembly on the outcomes
3 of the pilot program within one year after 4 years of full
4 implementation, and after 7 years of full implementation,
5 compared to typical treatment available to other youth with
6 significant mental health conditions, as well as the cost
7 savings associated with the pilot program taking into account
8 all public systems used when an individual with a significant
9 mental health condition does not have access to the right
10 treatment and supports in the early stages of his or her
11 illness.

12 The reports to the General Assembly shall be filed with the
13 Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary of the
14 Senate in electronic form only, in the manner that the Clerk
15 and the Secretary shall direct.

16 Post-pilot program discharge outcomes shall be collected
