2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2952 on page 16, by  
3 replacing lines 5 through 15 with the following:

4 "(b) The Prescription Monitoring Program Advisory  
5 Committee shall consist of 16 members appointed by the Clinical  
6 Director of the Prescription Monitoring Program ~~The Clinical~~  
7 ~~Director of the Prescription Monitoring Program shall appoint~~  
8 ~~members to serve on the advisory committee. The advisory~~  
9 ~~committee shall be~~ composed of prescribers and dispensers  
10 licensed to practice in his or her respective profession as  
11 follows: one family or primary care physician; one pain  
12 specialist physician; 4 other physicians licensed to practice  
13 ~~medicine in all its branches; 2~~ one advanced practice  
14 registered nurses ~~nurse~~; one physician assistant; one  
15 optometrist or ophthalmologist; one dentist; ~~one podiatric~~  
16 ~~physician;~~ one veterinarian; one representative from a  
17 statewide organization representing hospitals; and 3

2 "2019 members shall draw lots for initial terms and 6 members  
3 shall serve 3 years, 5 members shall serve 2 years, and 5".
