2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 3060 on page 56, by
3 replacing line 8 with the following:

4 "Service by email is complete on the date of transmission to
5 the email address of record. The Department shall adopt rules
6 that specify the standard for confirming delivery of documents
7 to the email address of record and, if delivery is not
8 confirmed, what steps the Department will take to ensure that
9 service to the email address of record or other means is
10 accomplished. Until the rules required by this Section are
11 adopted, the Department shall send a copy of the document via
12 certified mail to the licensee's address of record."; and

13 on page 58, by replacing lines 3 and 4 with the following:

14 "deposited in the U.S. mail. Service by email is complete on
15 the date of transmission to the email address of record. The
16 Department shall adopt rules that specify the standard for
17 confirming delivery of documents to the email address of record

1 and, if delivery is not confirmed, what steps the Department
2 will take to ensure that service to the email address of record
3 or other means is accomplished. Until the rules required by
4 this Section are adopted, the Department shall send a copy of
5 the document via certified mail to the licensee's address of
6 record."; and

7 on page 106, by replacing line 4 with the following:

8 "Service by email is complete on the date of transmission to
9 the email address of record. The Department shall adopt rules
10 that specify the standard for confirming delivery of documents
11 to the email address of record and, if delivery is not
12 confirmed, what steps the Department will take to ensure that
13 service to the email address of record or other means is
14 accomplished. Until the rules required by this Section are
15 adopted, the Department shall send a copy of the document via

17 on page 108, by replacing lines 10 and 11 with the following:

18 "notice is deposited in the U.S. Mail. Service by email is

20 record. The Department shall adopt rules that specify the
21 standard for confirming delivery of documents to the email
22 address of record and, if delivery is not confirmed, what steps
23 the Department will take to ensure that service to the email
24 address of record or other means is accomplished. Until the

1 rules required by this Section are adopted, the Department
2 shall send a copy of the document via certified mail to the
3 licensee's address of record.".
