#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

405 ILCS 80/Art. XII heading new  
405 ILCS 80/12-1 new  
405 ILCS 80/12-5 new

Amends the Developmental Disability and Mental Disability Services Act. Provides that the Department of Human Services shall: (1) oversee the transition of adult persons with developmental disabilities in the State who qualify for Medicaid Waiver services, who reside in intermediate care facilities for persons with developmental disabilities with 9 or more residents, and who affirmatively request to receive community-based services or placement in a community-based setting; and (2) oversee the transition of adult persons with developmental disabilities in the State who qualify for Medicaid Waiver services, who reside in a family home, who are in need of community-based services or placement in a community-based setting, and who affirmatively request community-based services or placement in a community-based setting. Effective immediately.

4 Section 5. The Developmental Disability and Mental  
5 Disability Services Act is amended by adding Article XII as

8 ARTICLE XII. COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES FOR PERSONS WITH  
9 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES

11 Sec. 12-1. Purpose. The purpose of this Article is to  
12 provide an opportunity for persons with developmental  
13 disabilities who reside in private, State-funded facilities of  
14 9 or more persons, or persons who are at risk of being placed  
15 in those facilities, to receive community-based services or  
16 placement in a community-based setting.

17 (405 ILCS 80/12-5 new)

18 Sec. 12-5. Community-based services for persons with  
19 developmental disabilities. The Department of Human Services  
20 shall:

21 (1) Oversee the transition of adult persons with

1       developmental disabilities in this State who qualify for  
2       Medicaid Waiver services, who reside in intermediate care  
3       facilities for persons with developmental disabilities  
4       with 9 or more residents, and who affirmatively request to  
5       receive community-based services or placement in a  
6       community-based setting.

7       (2) Oversee the transition of adult persons with  
8       developmental disabilities in this State who qualify for  
9       Medicaid Waiver services, who reside in a family home, who  
10      are in need of community-based services or placement in a  
11      community-based setting, and who affirmatively request  
12      community-based services or placement in a community-based  
13      setting.

14      Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
15      becoming law.
