1 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 54 WHEREAS, For southwest Illinois to remain a vibrant and 2 3 desired place to live and do business, the region's roadways 4 need to evolve to meet the needs of the area; and WHEREAS, Connecting the major population centers of 5 6 Southern Illinois will allow people, goods, and agriculture 7 commodities to be quickly transported; and 8 WHEREAS, Four counties in southwestern Illinois (Jackson, 9 Monroe, Perry, and Randolph), numerous municipalities in the 10 Southern Illinois University Carbondale, local area, businesses, labor unions, and agricultural organizations have 11 all voiced support for a four-lane, divided highway from 12 13 Waterloo to Murphysboro; and 14 WHEREAS, The proposed highway has come to be known as the 15 Southwest Illinois Connector; therefore, be it 16 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDREDTH GENERAL 17 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that the Southwest Illinois Connector Task 18 Force is created in order to study the following: 19 20 (1) the cost, feasibility, and environmental impact of

6	shall consist of the following members:

10	(4) the Minority Leader of the House of
11	Representatives, or his designee;
12	(5) the Secretary of Transportation, or his or her
13	designee;
14	(6) a representative of Randolph County appointed by
15	the Chairman of the Randolph County Board of Commissioners;
16	(7) a representative of Perry County appointed by the
17	Chairman of the Perry County Board of Commissioners;
18	(8) a representative of Jackson County appointed by the
19	Chairman of the Jackson County Board;
20	(9) a representative of Monroe County appointed by the
21	Chairman of the Monroe County Board of Commissioners;
22	(10) a representative of an organization representing
23	the Illinois agricultural industry appointed by its
24	President;
25	(11) a representative of Southern Illinois University

Carbondale appointed by its Chancellor;

- 2 (12) the president of a statewide labor federation 3 representing more than one international union, or his or her designee;
- (13) a representative of the Kaskaskia Regional Port 6 District appointed by its Chairman;
  - (14) a representative of an organization representing municipalities in Illinois appointed by its President; and
- 9 (15) a representative of an organization representing 10 realtors in Illinois appointed by its President; and be it 11 further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the Task Force members shall select a 1.3 Chairperson from among themselves; and be it further
- 14 RESOLVED, That members of the Southwest Illinois Connector 15 Task Force shall serve with no compensation; the Illinois Department of Transportation shall make all Department 16 information available to the Task Force and provide expertise 17 as needed and available; and be it further 18
- 19 RESOLVED, That the Southwest Illinois Connector Task Force 20 shall meet a minimum of four times and make recommendations to 21 General Assembly and the Illinois Department 22 Transportation before December 31, 2018; and be it further
