1 SENATE RESOLUTION WHEREAS, The month of April is designated nationally and 2 3 internationally as Autism Awareness Month; and WHEREAS, Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASDs) affect a growing 4 5 number of Illinois residents and their families; and 6 WHEREAS, According to the Centers for Disease Control and 7 Prevention, the prevalence of ASDs has increased from one in 150 children as of 2002, to one in 68 children today; based on 8 9 these figures, more than 40,000 school-age children in Illinois have an ASD; and 10 11 WHEREAS, In 2003, to improve the State's response to 12 autism, Illinois passed Public Act 93-395, which created The 13 Autism Program of Illinois (TAP); and 14 WHEREAS, TAP brings together universities and nonprofit organizations from across Illinois to implement a system of 15 care for those with ASD; and 16 17 WHEREAS, Over the past 14 years, TAP has developed into the largest statewide autism resource and service network in the 18 19 nation; and

- 1 WHEREAS, TAP currently operates centers or other programs
- 2 in partnership with the University of Illinois Chicago,
- 3 Illinois State University, Southern Illinois University,
- 4 Easter Seals Metropolitan Chicago-Rockford Service Center,
- 5 Easter Seals Central Illinois, RCADD Chicago, Trinity
- 6 Services, Kreider Services, the CTF Illinois, Little Friends
- 7 Inc., Have Dreams, and the Hope Institute for Children and
- 8 Families; and
- 9 WHEREAS, TAP has provided direct services to more than
- 10 8,500 Illinois families and trained more than 88,000 family
- 11 members, educators, health care providers, day care providers,
- 12 and first responders; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The TAP service model has been validated by
- 14 researchers at Baylor University with many major national
- organizations seeking partnership with TAP; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Despite TAP's many accomplishments, there remain
- 17 unmet needs, and much work needs to be done in Illinois;
- 18 therefore, be it
- 19 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDREDTH GENERAL
- 20 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we designate April 2,
- 21 2017 as World Autism Awareness Day in the State of Illinois;
- 22 and be it further

- 1 RESOLVED, That we congratulate the members of TAP and its
- 2 many partners on the occasion of its 14th anniversary, and
- 3 pledge our continuing support to Illinois families impacted by
- 4 autism; and be it further
- 5 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 6 presented to The Autism Program of Illinois.
