- WHEREAS, Judith Dallas was born in Granite City to Henry 5 6 and Ann (Stajduhar) Pieper on August 19, 1950; she married 7 William A. "Bill" Dallas Jr. at the former St. Joseph Catholic 8 Church in Granite City on September 15, 1973; and
 - WHEREAS, Judith Dallas was a 44-year veteran of enforcement and the criminal justice community, with 29 years at Madison County; her career started with the Granite City Police Department; she served as a detective secretary and chief's secretary before taking а doj senior as county's administrative assistant with the probation department in 1988; a year after she started working for the county she graduated with a bachelor's degree in sociology from Southern Illinois University Edwardsville; she worked her way up through the ranks, serving as supervisor, deputy chief, and chief probation officer; on March 14, 2008, she was named the first female director of the probation department; and
 - WHEREAS, Judith Dallas was a member of the Illinois Probation and Court Services Association, which awarded her the
