Local 2282 in Rock Island, Orion American Legion Post 255, and the Moline Turner's Club; he was a gifted woodworker and built homes, specializing in cabinetry and electrical work; he also built his home in Hawaii; he loved music and was a jazz enthusiast, especially enjoying Bix music; he enjoyed walking at the mall, playing golf, and listening to audio books; and

Army in Okinawa under General Douglas MacArthur; he was honored
