1 SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Robert Dean Stuart of Edwardsville, who 4 passed away on January 17, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Bob Stuart was born in Granite City to James and Verna Diehle Stuart on April 10, 1939; he graduated from Granite City High School in 1957; he then attended Missouri Valley College where he was a member of the Sigma Nu fraternity, lettered in basketball and golf, and graduated in 1961; he earned a master's degree in education administration from Southern Illinois University Edwardsville; he married Sandra Stephens at the Van Brunt Presbyterian Church in Kansas City, Missouri on June 25, 1961; and

WHEREAS, Bob Stuart had a long and distinguished career with the Edwardsville School District, which he began as a science teacher and coach for Edwardsville Junior High School in 1961; he was then named Assistant Principal of the junior high and went on to be the Principal of Glen Carbon Elementary School; in 1983, he was promoted to Director of Instruction for the district and then named Assistant Superintendent in Charge of Curriculum; in 1991, he was named Superintendent of Schools and remained in that position until he retired in 1996; he considered the passing of the referendum and overseeing the

1 construction of the new high school to be the highlight of his

- 4 Church of Edwardsville for over 50 years; he was a proud member
- 5 of DeMolay, the Jaycees, and the Rotary, where he was named a

- 7 YMCA Board and was commissioner for the Edwardsville Fire and
- 8 Police Commission; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Bob Stuart is survived by his wife of 57 years,
- Sandy; his two children, Stacy (Randy) Wimmer and Steve (Katie)
- 11 Stuart; and his grandchildren, Taylor (Jamie) Lockhart, and
