1 SENATE RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, A proposed new tax on miles traveled on public, 2 3 non-tolled Illinois roads using GPS tracking technology has 4 been proposed in the Illinois General Assembly; and 5 WHEREAS, Road user charges (RUCs), also known 6 mileage-based user fees (MBUFs) or vehicle miles traveled (VMT) 7 fees, would impose a new financial burden, raise privacy 8 concerns for Illinois residents, and make our State even less 9 competitive; and 10 WHEREAS, Such proposals would offer Illinois drivers a variety of bad options; and 11 WHEREAS, A GPS monitoring plan would create privacy 12 13 for all Illinoisans and expose personal concerns confidential information to the possibility of a data breach; 14 15 therefore, be it 16 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDREDTH GENERAL 17 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the General 18 Assembly not to impose road user charges; and be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That we state our firm opposition to any new tax 20 on miles traveled.
