WHEREAS, The Wisconsin General Assembly passed legislation 2 3 that incentivizes Foxconn Technology Group to open and operate 4 a facility in Racine County, Wisconsin that would waive 5 significant environment protections; and 6 WHEREAS, Foxconn will be allowed to discharge dredged 7 materials or fill wetlands without a permit and forego 8 environmental impact statements; and 9 WHEREAS, Racine County and the site chosen sits in the Des 10 Plaines watershed that also extends into Illinois; and WHEREAS, Wetlands are vital for clean water, flood water 11 12 storage, and ecological integrity; and 13 WHEREAS, Flooding in the Des Plaines River watershed and 14 throughout Lake County has cost billions of dollars and caused 15 severe damage; and
