WHEREAS, Tony Pintozzi was chairman of the Northern Illinois Medical Board, president of the Painting & Decorating Contractors Association of Northern Illinois, co-founder of the Northern Illinois Painting & Drywall Institute, chairman of the Painters District Council 30 Pension Fund, secretary of the Painters District Council 30 Health & Welfare Fund, and co-founder of the Finishing Contractors Association of Illinois; he served on the St. Patrick/Montini Catholic School Commission and was a St. Patrick Church lector; he was a member of the McHenry County Regional School Board and the city of McHenry Police Commissioner; he was also involved with Kiwanis, a member of the McHenry Country Club, and coached little
