1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 210

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 210 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Unified Code of Corrections is amended by  
5 adding Section 3-2-2.3 as follows:

6 (730 ILCS 5/3-2-2.3 new)

7 Sec. 3-2-2.3. Tamms Minimum Security Unit Task Force.

8 (a) The Tamms Minimum Security Unit Task Force is created  
9 to study using the Tamms Minimum Security Unit as a vocational  
10 training facility for the Department of Corrections. The  
11 membership of the Task Force shall include:

12 (1) one member of the House of Representatives  
13 appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

14 (2) one member of the House of Representatives  
15 appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of  
16 Representatives;

1           (3) one member of the Senate appointed by the Senate  
2           President;

3           (4) one member of the Senate appointed by the Senate  
4           Minority Leader;

5           (5) the Director of Corrections or his or her designee;

6           (6) one member representing a labor organization for  
7           Department of Corrections employees, appointed by the  
8           Director of Corrections;

9           (7) one member representing Shawnee Community College,  
10          appointed by the President of Shawnee Community College;

11          (8) one member representing Southern Illinois  
12          University, appointed by the President of Southern  
13          Illinois University;

14          (9) the mayor of Tamms, Illinois; and

15          (10) one member representing Alexander County,  
16          appointed by the Chairman of the Alexander County Board.

17          (b) Each member of the Task Force shall serve without  
18          compensation. The members of the Task Force shall select a  
19          Chairperson. The Task Force shall meet 2 times per year or at  
20          the call of the Chairperson. The Department of Corrections  
21          shall provide administrative support to the Task Force.

22          (c) The Task Force shall submit a report to the Governor  
23          and the General Assembly on or before December 31, 2020 with  
24          its recommendations. The Task Force is dissolved on January 1,  
25          2021.

26          (d) This Section is repealed on January 1, 2022."
