SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

755 ILCS 65/50

Amends the Disposition of Remains Act. Provides that any dispute concerning the right to control the disposition of a decedent's remains shall be resolved by a court within 30 days of the dispute being filed with the court.

AN ACT concerning civil law.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Disposition of Remains Act is amended by 5 changing Section 50 as follows:

6 (755 ILCS 65/50)

7 Sec. 50. Disputes. Any dispute among any of the persons listed in Section 5 concerning their right to control the 8 9 disposition, including cremation, of a decedent's remains 10 shall be resolved by a court of competent jurisdiction within 30 days of the dispute being filed with the court. A cemetery 11 organization or funeral establishment shall not be liable for 12 refusing to accept the decedent's remains, or to inter or 13 14 otherwise dispose of the decedent's remains, until it receives a court order or other suitable confirmation that the dispute 15 16 has been resolved or settled.
