## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/27-20.08 new

Amends the School Code. Provides that, beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, every public high school may include in its curriculum a unit of instruction on media literacy; defines "media literacy". Provides requirements for the unit of instruction. Provides that the State Superintendent of Education may prepare and make available to school boards instructional materials that may be used as guidelines for the unit of instruction. Effective immediately.

  9 access, analyze, evaluate, create, and communicate using a
  10 variety of forms, including, but not limited to, print, visual,
  11 audio, interactive, and digital texts.
- 12 (b) Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, every public

  13 high school may include in its curriculum a unit of instruction

  14 on media literacy. The unit of instruction shall include, but

  15 is not limited to, analyzing:
- 16 <u>(1) the purpose of media messages and how they are</u>
  17 constructed;
  - (2) explicit and implicit media messages;
