SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 66/50

Amends the Firearm Concealed Carry Act. Provides that a concealed carry license shall be renewed for a period of 5 years from the date of expiration on the applicant's current license upon the applicant completing the necessary requirements under the Act.

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Firearm Concealed Carry Act is amended by changing Section 50 as follows:
- 6 (430 ILCS 66/50)
- 7 Sec. 50. License renewal. Applications for renewal of a 8 license shall be made to the Department. A license shall be 9 renewed for a period of 5 years from the date of expiration on 10 the applicant's current license upon the receipt of a completed renewal application, completion of 3 hours of training required 11 under Section 75 of this Act, payment of the applicable renewal 12 fee, and completion of an investigation under Section 35 of 13 14 this Act. The renewal application shall contain the information required in Section 30 of this Act, except that the applicant 15 16 need not resubmit a full set of fingerprints.
