SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/5-12022 new 65 ILCS 5/11-13-28 new

Amends the Counties Code and the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that county or municipality may not prohibit a private homeowner from gardening on his or her property. Limits home rule powers. Effective immediately.

- 14 Section 10. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
- adding Section 11-13-28 as follows:

- Sec. 11-13-28. Gardening. A municipality may not prohibit a
- 18 private homeowner from gardening on his or her property.
- A home rule municipality may not regulate gardening in a
- 20 manner inconsistent with this Section. This Section is a
- 21 limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of

- 3 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 4 becoming law.
