1 when a holiday occurs during the week, or in a musical recital or concert: Provided, that such minor is accompanied by his 2 3 parent or guardian or by a person in whose care the parent or 4 guardian has placed the minor and whose connection with the 5 performance or with the operation of the theatre in which the 6 minor is to appear is limited to the care of such minor or of minors appearing therein: And provided further, that such minor 7 8 shall not appear on said stage or in a musical recital or 9 concert, attend rehearsals, or be present in connection with 10 such appearance or rehearsals, in the theatre where the play or 11 musical comedy is produced or in the place where the concert or recital is given, for more than a total of six (6) hours in any 12 13 one day, or on more than six (6) days in any one week, or for 14 more than a total of twenty-four (24) hours in any one week, or 15 after the hour of 11 postmeridian; and provided further, no 16 such minor shall be excused from attending school except as authorized pursuant to Section 26-1 of the School Code. 17 18 Application for such certificate shall be made by the manager of the theatre, or by the person in the district responsible 19 20 for the musical recital or concert, and by the parent or 21 guardian of such minor to the City or County Superintendent of 22 Schools or his authorized agent at least fourteen (14) days in 23 advance of such appearance. The City or County Superintendent 24 of Schools or his agent may issue a permit if satisfied that 25 adequate provision has been made for the educational instruction of such minor, for safeguarding his health and for 26

the proper moral supervision of such minor, and that proper rest and dressing room facilities are provided in the theatre for such minor.

4 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Act, the City or 5 Regional Superintendent of Schools, or their duly authorized agents, are authorized to issue an employment certificate for 6 any minor under 16 years of age, such certificate authorizing 7 8 and permitting the appearance of such minor as a model or in a 9 motion picture, radio or television production: Provided, that 10 no such minor shall be excused from attending school except as authorized pursuant to Section 26-1 of The School Code. The 11 Department of Labor shall promulgate rules and regulations to 12 carry out the provisions of this subsection. Such rules and 13 14 regulations shall be designed to protect the health and welfare 15 of child models or actors and to insure that the conditions 16 under which minors are employed, used or exhibited will not impair their health, welfare, development or proper education. 17

(c) In situations where a minor from another state seeks to 18 obtain an Illinois employment certificate, the Department 19 20 shall work with a City or Regional Superintendent of Schools, or the State Superintendent of Education, or his or her duly 21 22 authorized agents, to issue the certificate. The 23 Superintendent may waive the requirement in Section 12 of this 24 Act that a minor submit his or her application in person, if 25 the minor resides in another state.

26 (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, a

1 parent of a home-schooled student under the age of 16 shall be authorized to issue an employment certificate for his or her 2 3 child for any occupation except those occupations enumerated in 4 Section 7. 5 (Source: P.A. 96-1247, eff. 7-23-10.)".
