2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**

4 Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by  
5 adding Section 194 as follows:

7 Sec. 194. Illinois Constitution Day. August 26 of each year  
8 is designated as Illinois Constitution Day, to be observed  
9 throughout the State as a day to commemorate August 26, 1818 as  
10 the day Illinois ratified its first State Constitution.
