SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

405 ILCS 5/2-101.1

Amends the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Code. Provides that until the consent of the adult's guardian has been obtained, counseling or psychotherapy provided to an adult under guardianship shall be limited to not more than 12 (rather than 5) sessions, a session lasting not more than 60 (rather than 45) minutes. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental
- 5 Disabilities Code is amended by changing Section 2-101.1 as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (405 ILCS 5/2-101.1)
- 8 Sec. 2-101.1. Counseling services; consent; costs.
- 9 (a) Any adult under quardianship may request and receive counseling services or psychotherapy. The consent of the 10 guardian shall not be necessary to authorize counseling or 11 psychotherapy. The adult's guardian shall not be informed, 12 without the consent of the adult, of such counseling or 13 14 psychotherapy unless the counselor or therapist believes such disclosure is necessary. If the counselor or therapist intends 15 16 to disclose the fact of counseling or psychotherapy, the adult shall be so informed. However, until the consent of the adult's 17 guardian has been obtained, counseling or psychotherapy 18 provided to an adult under guardianship shall be limited to not 19 20 more than 12 $\frac{5}{2}$ sessions, a session lasting not more than 60 $\frac{45}{2}$ 21 minutes.
- 22 (b) The adult's guardian shall not be liable for the costs 23 of counseling or psychotherapy which is received by the adult

- without the consent of the adult's guardian.
