SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1605/7.8b new

Amends the Illinois Lottery Law. Requires lottery tickets and instant scratch-off tickets to provide whether the proceeds from the purchase go toward the Common School Fund or a special cause. Requires the Department of the Lottery to adopt rules to implement the requirements, including providing the size of the description to be printed or published. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Lottery Law is amended by adding Section 7.8b as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 1605/7.8b new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 7.8b. Proceed disclosures on lottery tickets.</u>
- (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), on and after the 8 9 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 101st General 10 Assembly, a ticket or share or instant scratch-off sold under this Act shall provide that the proceeds from the sale of the 11 12 ticket or share or instant scratch-off go towards the Common School Fund or, for special instant scratch-off games 13 14 established under Sections 21.5, 21.6, 21.7, 21.8, 21.9, 21.10, and 21.11, the cause for which the special instant scratch-off 15 16 was established.
 - (b) On and after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 101st General Assembly, if a multi-state game ticket is sold in the State through an electronic device, then the sales screen used by the customer to purchase the multi-state game ticket shall provide that the proceeds from the sale of the multi-state game ticket go toward the Common School Fund.
- 23 <u>(c) The Department shall adopt rules to implement the</u>

- 1 requirements of subsections (a) and (b). The rules shall
- 2 provide for the size, in typographic points, of the description
- 3 to be printed or published and the abbreviations that may be
- 4 used to make the description readable, whether the ticket or
- 5 share is printed or electronically published.
- 6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 7 becoming law.
