SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 66/60

Amends the Firearms Concealed Carry Act. Provides that for a new or renewal concealed carry license, the fee shall be \$75 (rather than \$150), of which \$60 (rather than \$120) shall be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$5 (rather than \$20) shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund. Provides that a non-resident applicant for a new license or renewal shall submit \$150 (rather than \$300) and a licensee requesting a new license shall submit \$10 (rather than \$75). Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Firearm Concealed Carry Act is amended by 5 changing Section 60 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 66/60)

7 Sec. 60. Fees.

8 (a) All fees collected under this Act shall be deposited as 9 provided in this Section. Application, renewal, and 10 replacement fees shall be non-refundable.

11 (b) An applicant for a new license or a renewal shall 12 submit $\frac{575}{5150}$ with the application, of which $\frac{60}{5120}$ shall 13 be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, $\frac{55}{520}$ 14 $\frac{520}{520}$ shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, 15 and \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory 16 Fund.

(c) A non-resident applicant for a new license or renewal shall submit \$150 \$300 with the application, of which \$100 \$250 shall be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$40 shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.

(d) A licensee requesting a new license in accordance with

Section 55 shall submit \$10 \$75, of which \$5 \$60 shall be
 apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$5 shall
 be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$5 \$10
 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.
