SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/29-21 new

Amends the Election Code. Prohibits a person from knowingly maintaining more than one registration to vote. Provides that a violation involving multiple registrations within the State is a Class A misdemeanor. Provides that a violation involving multiple registrations in this State and another state is a Class 4 felony. Provides an affirmative defense to the violation.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning elections.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by adding Section
5 29-21 as follows:

6 (10 ILCS 5/29-21 new)

7 Sec. 29-21. Registering more than once. No person may
8 knowingly maintain more than one registration to vote. A
9 violation of this Section involving multiple registrations
10 within the State is a Class A misdemeanor; a violation of this
11 Section involving multiple registrations, where one or more
12 registrations is within this State and one or more registration
13 is within another state, is a Class 4 felony. It is an
14 affirmative defense to a violation of this Section that the
15 individual has voted only once in any election for which the
16 individual has more than one registration to vote.
