

## 101ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2019 and 2020 HB2724

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/11-1432 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a person shall not operate or be in actual physical control of a motor vehicle while a person in the motor vehicle is smoking if a person under 18 years of age is in the motor vehicle. Defines smoking as inhaling, exhaling, burning, or carrying a lighted cigarette, cigar, pipe, weed, plant, regulated narcotic, or other combustible substance. Provides that a police officer may not stop a motor vehicle solely for a violation of the new provisions. Provides that a violation is a petty offense with a maximum fine of \$100. Provides that motorcycles and convertible motor vehicles in open-air or top down mode are exempt from this provision.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Section 11-1432 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/11-1432 new)
- Sec. 11-1432. Prohibit smoking in a motor vehicle with a
- 8 <u>minor present.</u>
- 9 <u>(a) For purposes of this Section:</u>
- "Smoking" means to inhale, exhale, burn, or carry a lighted

  cigarette, cigar, pipe, weed, plant, regulated narcotic, or
- other combustible substance.
- (b) A person shall not operate or be in actual physical
- 14 control of a motor vehicle while a person in the motor vehicle
- is smoking if a person under 18 years of age is in the motor
- 16 <u>vehicle. This Section does not apply to the operator of a</u>
- 17 <u>motorcycle or a motor vehicle with a convertible or removable</u>
- 18 roof in top-down, topless, or open air mode.
- (c) A police officer may not stop or detain a motor vehicle
- or its driver solely for a violation or suspected violation of
- 21 <u>this Section.</u>
- 22 (d) A violation of this Section is a petty offense with a
- fine not to exceed \$100.
