2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 2816 by replacing
3 line 16 on page 3 through line 5 on page 4 with the following:

4 "discretion of the court. No legal fees, appointed counsel

6 against the Office of the State Guardian, the public guardian,
7 an adult protective services agency, the Department of Children
